

**General requirements:**

text written in Word editor, Times New Roman font, 12 points, min. 1000 - max. 4200 characters, graphs in black and white, pictures also in color (not included in the text). For photomicrographs, staining and magnification must be specified. At the end, the possible consent of the ethics committee and dedication to the research task are given. The surnames and first names of authors and co-authors are given in full.

**References:**

surname in whole, followed by a comma, names by an abbreviation of the first capital letter, followed by a dot, if there are more authors, a dot and a comma are behind the last letter. The first three authors are listed, if there are more than one, only the first one is given and "et al." Behind the Names is the year of publication of the thesis, the title of the thesis at the end with a dot, followed by the volume number, the number of the journal in parentheses, followed a colon after the parenthesis indicating the page.
